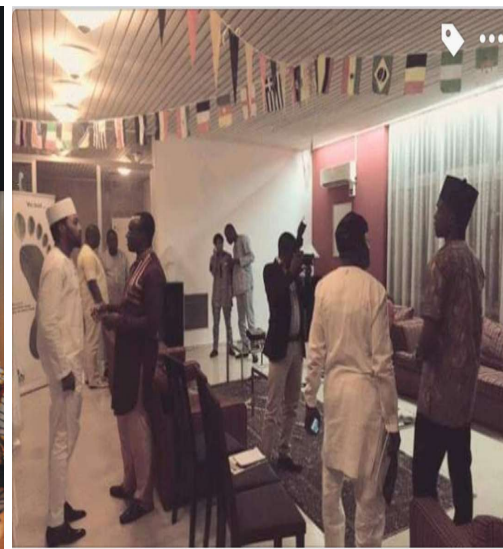
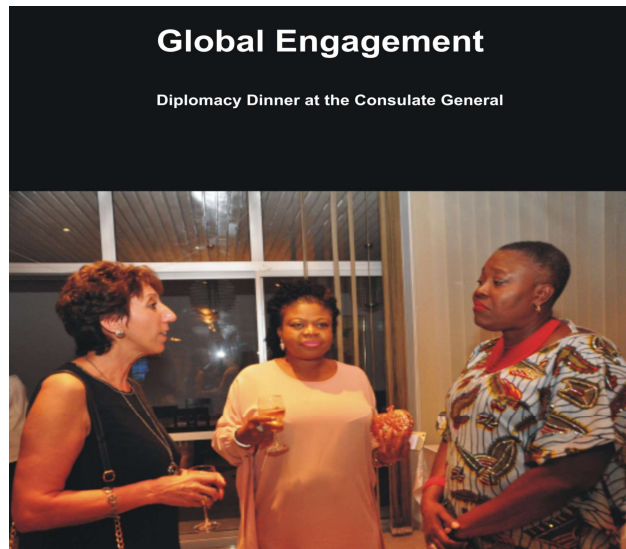

EDUCATION

Citizen Diplomacy bureau (GRFPCP) believes every child has the right to proper education. It is key to building an independent, successful life and a chance to escape poverty. Education gives children an opportunity to find their strengths and empowers them to pursue careers and to provide for themselves, as well as their present and future families. Citizen Diplomacy bureau understands that education is critical for the development of the society as a whole. By giving more children access to education, the benefits will inevitably filter through into the wider community. It means that more children will live a life free of exploitation. CITIZEN DIPLOMACY BUREAU'S (GRFPCP) Goal is to enable and support children and young people in their education. To bring not just children to education, but also to bring education to children. Childhood should be a time of fun and learning.

EMERGENCY RESPONSE – VOLUNTEER

Citizen Diplomacy bureau (GRFPCP) works to deliver a 24 hour, 7 days a week response unit, consisting of social workers, who respond immediately to those in need. The Unit attends to victims of domestic violence, human trafficking, human rights violations and medical needs. The Unit particularly focuses on the most vulnerable throughout Africa, its street dwelling children and women. Where possible and appropriate, the Unit reunites individuals with their families, assists below poverty-line families to access medical care and through strong referral networks, places at-risk individuals into appropriate shelters and homes. The Unit also receives calls from the Nigerian Police and Fire Department, to respond to crises calls throughout the city, particularly road accidents, which are common among street dwellers.

A CHILD, A SHELTER.....

For the last three years citizen Diplomacy bureau (global relations foundation) have supported more than 300 hundred vulnerable schools, through rehabilitation and student support packages and scholarships to prepare young children for a better future and help out of mental slavery and human trafficking vices

PROTECTION

The Citizen Diplomacy bureau's (GRFPCP) primary objective is the protection of children who live on the streets and in the slums of Africa. Child protection is about rescuing children from exploitation, abuse, starvation and sickness. It's about protecting the most vulnerable in the society and providing them with immediate care. Depending on the needs of the child, they may go on to live in one of our protection homes where they will receive our care and support for as long as they need it. There is no limit to our care. Children rescued by Citizen Diplomacy bureau will have a family and support for life, not just until they turn 18. Other children we rescue may return to live with their families, while receiving on-going community based support from Citizen Diplomacy bureau. We work to offer alternatives to child labor so that children have childhoods. Citizen Diplomacy (GRF) is also engaged in initiatives to prevent child trafficking. We believe it should never hurt to be a child. The Citizen Diplomacy bureau works to restore childhoods to traumatized and abandoned children. Our Child-Watch Programme takes positive action to protect children at risk through our emergency response team. Health experts and volunteers patrol the streets of Africa every night, responding to those in need.

HEALTHCARE AND NUTRITION

Through our health care programme, Citizen Diplomacy bureau brings health services and practical health advice to needy communities in Africa. Improving the health of children and families living in the slums of Africa is one of The Citizen Diplomacy bureau's priorities, and is key in the fight against poverty. Healthy children, who become healthy adults, create better lives for themselves and their families. Through our healthcare programme, we have made significant progress in immunization, water sanitation and ante-natal care, saving the lives of thousands of infants and their mothers. Our aim at Citizen Diplomacy bureau is to provide ancillary services to strengthen the existing health services that are provided by the Government of Nigeria and Africa as a whole. Over the past decade we've developed strong partnerships with local non-governmental organizations, and work together delivering services in 34 communities.

CHILD HUNGER ALLEVIATION PROJECT

Citizen Diplomacy bureau works to take children off the streets and relieve under privileged families from lives of pain, segregation, abuse and poverty.

The Citizen Diplomacy Bureau (GRFPCP), rescues abused and abandoned children from the streets and slums of Africa. Citizen Diplomacy Bureau restores childhoods and provides the supports necessary to build better futures for children and vulnerable families. A staggering 250 thousand children in Africa are living with little or no shelter. To survive, children scavenge in rubbish dumps to find scraps to sell, or beg on the streets. Most of them have not been privileged enough to see the 4 walls of a classroom and they also suffer from poor health. Many of these children have been abandoned and are at high risk of abuse, exploitation and child trafficking. The Citizen Diplomacy Bureau, works inside the slums and on the streets bringing life-changing services and support to the most vulnerable and under-privileged children. Citizen Diplomacy Bureau runs 60 on the ground projects in Africa, 12 of which are protection homes. We work with children and their wider communities to effect positive and sustainable change. ADMISSION RESETTLEMENT PROCESS FOCUS

FOCUS: Refugee returnees, human trafficked victims, potential illegal migrants and other vulnerable people whose lives have been upended by war, conflict and natural disasters will be admitted into the service center program with free accommodation and feeding allowance within duration of training and process of rehabilitation.

RESETTLEMENT PROCESS: the international relief project (service center) will help Refugee returnees, human trafficking victims, potential illegal migrants and other vulnerable people re-integrate, stabilize and rebuild their lives, helping them to succeed and thrive successfully.

FOCUS: Places in Nigeria where refugee returnees, human trafficking victims, potential illegal migrants and vulnerable people don't have refugee assistance, facilitation for professional skills development, vocational training and the support they need to recover from crisis.

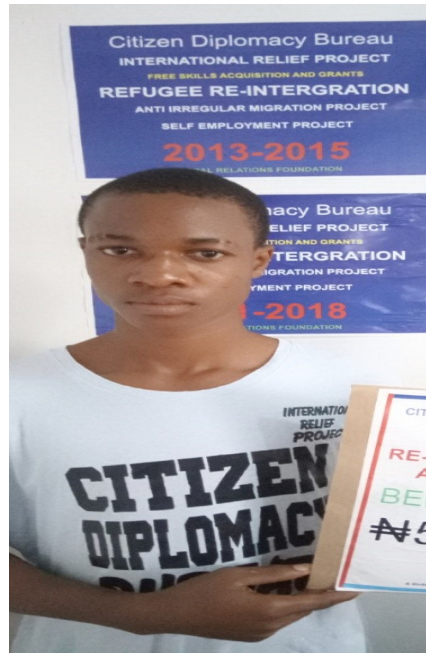

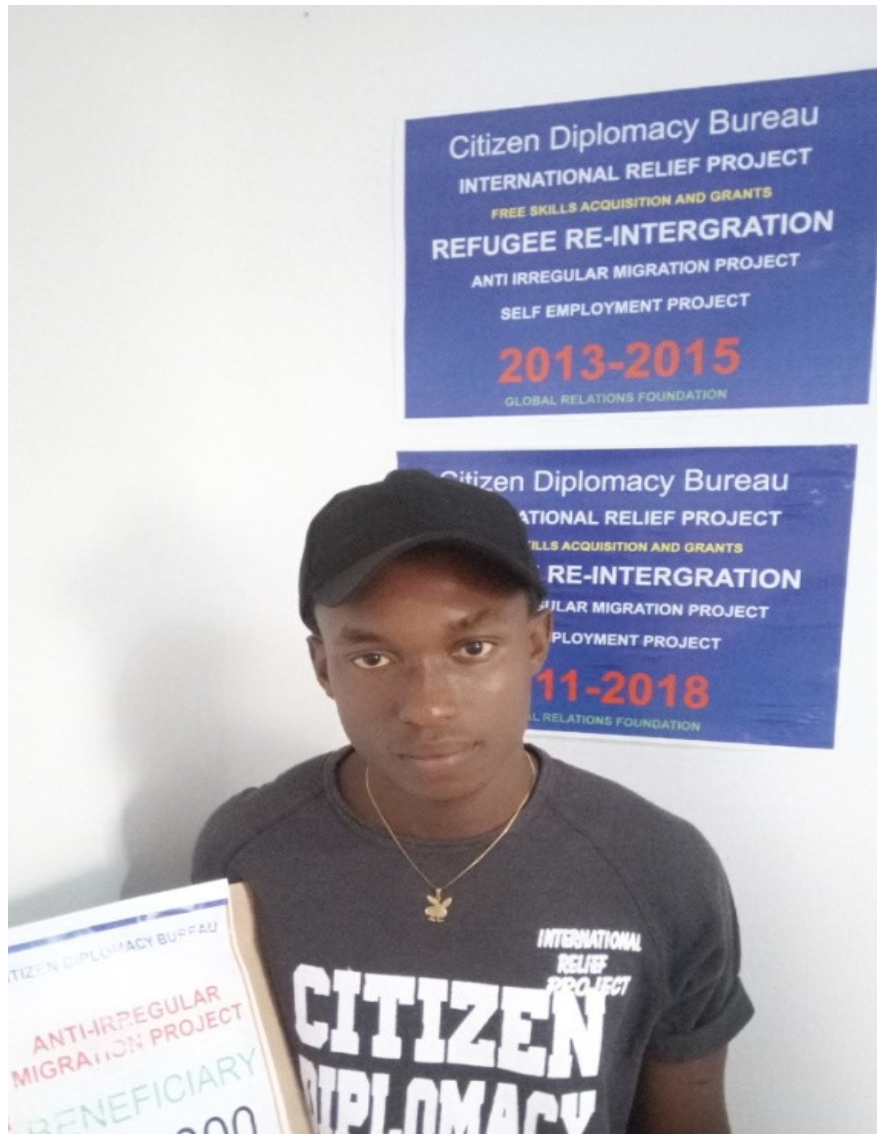

Institute delivers high-quality vocational training to individuals that are unable to avail of such services elsewhere. Professionally designed training, which is tailored to suit the capabilities of the trainees, provides the young women and men with the opportunity to receive training and a job placement to provide for their families. The institute was initially set up to help distressed and victimized women. Now it's also open to young people from Citizen Diplomacy bureau protection homes, This will specifically be for kids who have not received formal education. Citizen Diplomacy bureau runs further vocational training in Africa through a separate training institute operated by our partner, which is overseen and monitored by Citizen Diplomacy bureau. Training within Life-skills encompasses practical approaches and hands-on learning. These skills empower trainees, build confidence and enable them gain employment. Each training course is complimented with a certificate upon completion and work placement opportunities, demonstrating how this institute operates as a stepping stone for trainees to enter the wider work environments. This programme ensures they can earn wages, hence breaking the cyclical poverty trap they were previously faced with.

AWARENESS AND CAPACITY BUILDING

Creating awareness of the difficulties and injustice faced by so many in Africa and the work that we do here at Citizen Diplomacy bureau. This means voicing issues and solutions to local government, local and global societies, and working within the communities facing these challenges to empower individuals and effect lasting change.
